I wanted to update everyone on my recent trip to Africa this past fall, specifically my work in and around Kayunga, Uganda. I was involved in:

- * Installing a water tower at the New Tender Mercies building site
- * Arranging for building permits, town council approval, and a contractor, so that soon we can begin construction on the new Tender Mercies orphanage
- * Building 13 biosand filters
- * Organizing 4 native volunteers to continue making biosand filters and maintaining them
- * Tending to sick students
- * Working in the garden on the drip irrigation and the harvest
- * Visiting the new water well in Bugala village that was drilled in February, 2011
- * Coordinating a Sickle Cell clinic and treating 160 people with Sickly Cell

My most enjoyable work was spending time with the students, whose sponsors give so generously through AIDSpirit, USA. It is inspiring to know and see that prayers and financial support are giving them better lives and brighter futures.
